

Essex Land Rover Club Ltd Supplementary Regulations For Tyro Trials

To be held under general regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the international sporting code of the FIA) and these supplementary regulations.

Competitor Requirements

Tyro trials are open to any driver over the age of 13 who must be a member of ELRC or any invited MSA recognized club. Any drivers not holding a valid driving License must be passengered by a fully licensed club member and must only drive the observed section. Any participant under the age of 18 must be endorsed by a parent/guardian. Full driving licensed drivers may take passenger in the front seat aged 12 and above and from 2 years of age, correctly restrained in appropriate seating in the rear of the vehicle all passengers must face forwards. Current membership card is to be shown at signing on.

Trial start times and Scrutineering details

Tyro trials will, unless stated, take place on the Saturday of any given trial weekend. Signing on and scrutineering will open at 10.30, and close at 11.45. There will be a drivers briefing at 11.50 and the trial will commence at 12.00. All drivers must sign-on before their vehicle can be scrutineered.

Entry fee

Unless otherwise stated £18 pre booked or £25 on the day of the event.

Vehicle Requirements

Vehicle specifications are to be factory standard production specification and comply with the 2019 ALRC regulations. It is acceptable to remove spoilers and the like although this should not be necessary.

Seat belts must be worn as designed, Windscreen raised, full set of hood sticks and tilt in place, the rear flap on tilt may be open. The whole of a manufacturers hardtop or truck cab with all fastenings secured and all glass in position. Hardtops, truck cabs, tilts and door tops must be in place. All vehicles must have a current Vehicle and Operator Services Agency MOT test certificate where required by law: and vehicle excise license. Vehicles must enter on their normal road legal tyres (i.e. those on which they arrive at the event). Vehicles over 95" wheelbase are allowed one reverse (shunt) per section which can be taken at the drivers' discretion. Minimum tyre pressure is 22 psi. Classes will be based on vehicle wheelbase.

Practice

All competitors are allowed, and strongly advised, to walk the section when indicated to do so by the Clerk of the Course (or his nominated deputy), usually just prior to that section being used.

Results

Results will be posted as soon as all the course furniture is cleared and packed into the trailer and prize giving will take place 15 minutes later.
